

Challenges






...The Agony of the Feet




Jerry Knight. *Practicing for retirement.*








Nick MacMillan. *This is me and my new boat at Lake McConaughy (aka Big Mac). Our little piece of California in the middle of Nebraska.*



Mike Knight on duty with the Rifle (Colo) P.D. *C'mon, Officer Mike, you know they got that speed limit too low!*






Brian Curtis likes to make noises with wood and wires of wound metal.




Stuart (Mac) MacMillan. *I built it from scratch...but the question is, will it sail or sink?*


